NOPD GRANTS AUDITED

The City of New Orleans Inspector General today released a report on NOPD's grant expenditures. Five grants from 2011 and 2012 with expenditures of \$3,133,317 were audited.

Auditors found that NOPD had under-billed a state (federal pass-through) grant by \$59,235 in 2011, had not monitored activity for overtime and computer purchases and that serial numbers on computers did not match those on invoices.

Inspector General Ed Quatrevaux said, "The discrepancies found were not material to the grants tested, but do identify areas for improvement."
