**AIRPORT CREDIT CARD CHARGES SLASHED**

The City of New Orleans Inspector General today released a Follow-Up Report on Aviation Board Credit Card Activity.

The review found that the New Orleans Aviation Board revised its policies in response to all twelve recommended actions and consistently enforced those policies. Credit card transactions decreased by 89% when compared to the same period in 2008, and the dollar amount decreased from \$133,873 to \$17,784, an 87% reduction.

Inspector General Ed Quatrevaux said, "The report is further evidence of the transformation of Louis Armstrong airport and its leadership deserves praise for its actions."
